Regarding Public Hearing for Potential Annexation of Premises on west side of Edwina Street

WHEREAS, the Town Clerk, on or about May 1, 2023 received a copy of a Petition seeking annexation by the Village of premises consisting of approximately 2.366 unimproved acres in the Town of Starkey contiguous to the Village of Dundee, being a part of Tax Map parcel No. 120.02-1-3, owned by Steven C. Hill, Darla D. Hill, Christy Buono and Jared Hill; and

WHEREAS, the General Municipal Law (GML) of the State of New York requires the Petition to also be served upon the municipality in which the property to be annexed is located, ie: the Village of Dundee, which reportedly has been served; and

WHEREAS, the GML requires that within twenty (20) days of the completion of such service a public hearing be scheduled for a joint meeting of the boards of the municipalities involved, to wit: the Town Board of the Town of Starkey and the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dundee and;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, THAT

- 1. For purposes of SEQR issues, the Town Board consents to the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dundee to serve as "Lead Agency", declares this potential annexation to be an "unlisted" action and therefore a Short Environmental Assessment Form (SEAF) will be prepared and reviewed.
- 2. The Town Clerk is authorized and directed to schedule a timely joint public hearing with the Board of Trustees of the Village of Dundee and provide for the requisite notice thereof upon the availability of the municipal boards at a mutually agreed location and time.
